






SOLAR STATIONS FOR THE PUBLIC TRANSPORT DEPOT AND THE SEWAGE TREATMENT INSTALLATIONS

PROBLEM AND NEEDS TO BE SOLVED IN THE PROJECT

A strategic document has been developed in the region — the Regional Waste Management Plan in Sumy Oblast until 2030 (RWMP). The RWMP envisages the closure of existing household waste disposal facilities in the cluster and the creation of one household waste disposal facility - the regional landfill in the Konotop community.


PROJECT OBJECTIVE: establishment of an integrated household waste management system within the Konotop-Romny cluster

The cluster includes 16 territorial communities

Total population of the cluster - 301.917 thousand people

The estimated amount of household waste generated was approximately **90575 tons per year**







The specific objectives of the project

 construction of a regional landfill using modern technological solutions to ensure the disposal of household waste in the Konotop-Romny cluster in compliance with all environmental safety requirements instead of the current uncontrolled waste disposal;

- construction of a sorting line to increase the volume of resource-rich components to be recovered from household waste and sent for recycling;
- construction of a biowaste composting facility to reduce the amount of biowaste decomposing at the landfill and return part of the organic matter to the ecological cycle;
- reducing greenhouse gas emissions from household waste disposal.
