- Big wine industries and small family based wine cellars;



Wine tourism


- Big wineries with developed tourism infrastructure;



2. Arrangement of a tourist recreation area near the monument of Ilia Chavchavadze on "Iliaz Hill" in the city of Kvareli


Goal - Increased attractiveness of the municipality for the business sector due to the arrangement of another tourist-recreational area;
